OUTDOORSY

Splurge For nature on steroids, it doesn't get better than the eco-chic **Clayoquot Wilderness Resort** in remote Tofino, on Vancouver Island, British Columbia. You'll have the waves all to yourself while surfing, glimpse soaring bald eagles and breaching orcas, and hike through old-growth forests before soaking in a cedar hot tub and crashing in your seriously luxe safari-style tent.

Stretch Overlooking the crashing waves of the Pacific and set against the backdrop of redwood

forests (with blissfully terrible cell reception), **Ventana Big Sur** lets you unplug after all that wedding insanity. You'll take a guided flora and fauna hike, do a little yoga, and have amazing alfresco meals—like Ora King salmon and a delicious pour from the resort's 10,000-bottle cellar of Central Coast wines.

Save Jackson, Wyoming, is a skier's paradise during winter, but it's arguably even more special in summer and fall. The hip and modern **Anvil Hotel** (with just enough Gold Rush references) is where you'll want to relax after riding horses through the backcountry, hiking in Yellowstone, and fly-fishing on the Snake River.
